Camp #1 (Acting): Students entering first, second and third grades will learn acting skills and choreography and will build a play in a week. This is a basic introduction to the process of stage acting. This class is designed to help the younger actor learn basic stage directions and theatre etiquette, develop teamwork and ensemble-building skills, and explore public speaking skills with confidence and preparation for future FYTC Success.

Camp: Monday-Friday 1:00-2:30 p.m., July 11-15 with a performance on Saturday morning at 10:00 AM July 16th.

Camp #2 (Acting and Improvisation) Students entering fourth through eighth grade will gain experience in acting through use of movement, voice, and imagination. Through different activities and exercises, students will develop the techniques necessary to follow basic stage directions, project their voice, create characters, improvise scenes, and work as an ensemble. Over the course of the week, students will create a play that includes both scripted and improvised scenes. This performance will be presented at the end of the week for friends and family. Through this class, students will gain the experience necessary for success in future theatrical productions.
